

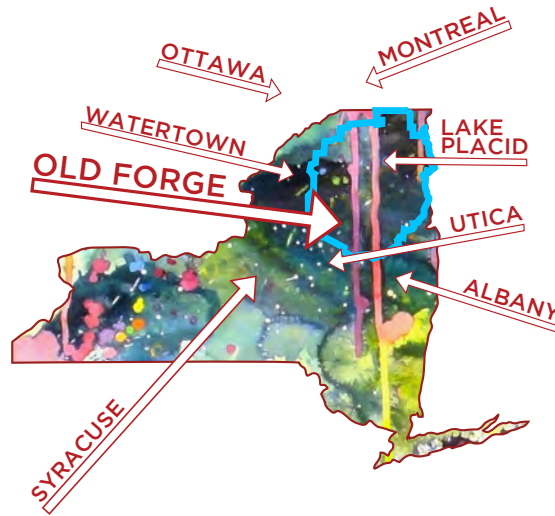


COME SEE

EXHIBITIONS

View encourages both the creation of art and the contemplative experience of viewing art by hosting exhibitions with regional and national appeal. New work is presented every four to six weeks.

Recognized and emerging artists working in every discipline and medium are featured in conjunction with a diverse spectrum of notable national shows. The *Adirondacks National Exhibition of American Watercolors* is widely considered to be one of the top five of its kind in North America. It is part of an annual series whose highlights include the *Northeast National Pastel Exhibition*, the *Central Adirondack Art Show*, and *Quilts Unlimited*.

PERFORMANCES

The new 200-seat, acoustically enhanced Gould Hall provides an intimate setting inviting audiences to appreciate a broad array of performances. The adaptable space allows professional and community presentations in all genres including live theatre, music, dance, and film. The hall transforms to accommodate Broadway style musicals with auditorium seating or intimate bistro jazz club settings.

WORKSHOPS

View's commitment to art education is evidenced in its extensive offerings of workshops. The diverse offerings include fine arts, crafts, wellness, and culinary arts.

The Meyda Tiffany Creative Arts Wing includes a catering and teaching kitchen, large, well-equipped classrooms, and a 1,600-square-foot, state-of-the-art ceramics studio.

View has regional, national, and internationally known instructors to assist students in honing their skills.

SPECIAL EVENTS

View hosts an array of special events that take advantage of the Adirondack setting, as well as the center's picturesque grounds. Annual festivals, auctions, social events and our gala support and celebrate the arts throughout the year.
