Gather your scraps! Do try to stay with a general theme or mood to your fabric choices. These blocks are addictive, so beware...

For example: juvenile prints with stripes and dots traditional prints, some floral, some geometric contemporary prints with batiks

- 1. **Background Fabric**: White/off-white/tea dye muslin or light tone on tone 64 3½ inch squares (¾ yard total fabric)
- 2. Scrap A: Medium or Dark 64 3-inch squares
 - i. (3/4 yard total fabric)
- Scrap B: Medium or Dark color coordinate with Scrap A 32 6-inch squares.
 i. (2 yards total fabric)
- 4. **Inner Sashings**: 1½" x 5½" strips, 64.
 - 1. (1/2 yard total fabric)
- 5. **Cornerstones and 4 or 8 pointed Stars**: 1/2 yard of a solid coordinating fabric. Pick one that will sparkle against your other fabrics, aka a "zinger".
- 6. **<u>Block Sashings</u>**: ¹/₂ yard of a single coordinating fabric (for some unity to your scrappy theme)
- Border 1 and 2: ¹/₂ yard each of two coordinating fabrics (consider repeating a fabric from scrap A or B.
- 8. **<u>Piano Keys</u>**: 1½" x 5½" strips, 240. Cut from all of your fabrics.

If you are scrap less (how sad...) consider buying fat quarters to give your quilt variety or consider sharing your fabrics with friends in the workshop.

Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing Machine in good working order with ¹/₄ foot
- Sewing Machine Manual if you use this machine infrequently
- Extra Sewing Machine Needles
- Rotary Cutter and Mat
- Fabric Scissors
- Silk pins
- Neutral or coordinating thread
- Rulers: 3" x 18" Omnigrid or similar
 - 6" Bias Square That Patchwork Place or
 - 6¹/₂" Easy Square Jr Sharon Hultgren
- 40" square of cotton batting or felt to use as a design wall
- Painter's tape
- Hard pressing surface and hot iron
- \$10 for pattern
