Trip Around the World Quilt

Supply List ~ View Arts

1. Fabrics: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard (not a fat quarter) each of four, 3-step value gradations from dark to medium to light for the quilt center. (12 pieces total)

Class sample used:

- a. $\frac{1}{4}$ yd of each ~ Light, Medium, Dark Pink
- b. $\frac{1}{4}$ yd of each ~ Light, Medium, and Dark Gold
- c. $\frac{1}{4}$ yd of each ~ Light, Medium, and Dark Purple
- d. $\frac{1}{4}$ yd of each ~ Light, Medium, and Dark Turquoise

All fabrics should be washed in hot water, hung to dry, starched (use spray starch, not sizing, on the wrong side) and ironed to crisp before class. Roll onto a pool noodle to transport to class.

2. Border and binding: $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd. of fabric which does not need to come to class unless a design consult is sought.
3. Sewing machine in good working order - if this is a machine you use infrequently, bring the sewing machine manual along with you.
4. Sewing Supplies/Notions: including neutral or matching threads.
Anything that you need to sew comfortably. Label all supplies, etc. with your name before class.
5. Large rotary cutting mat and rotary cutter with a new blade.
6. 6" x 18" clear ruler (2 if possible)
7. Hard surface pressing board
8. Iron – Steam iron
9. \$10 for pattern
